Garnacha Tintorera is known for its deep, inky color, and for coating the glass on the swirl. A juicy and succulent wine with aromas of blueberry and blackberry. Layered and very rich with hints of white pepper to complement the fruit.

Bodegas Atalaya was founded in 2007. The prominent grape variety in Almansa is Garnacha Tintorera along with Monastrell.

Both the winery facilities and the vineyards are at an average altitude of 1,000 meters (3,280 feet) above sea level.
