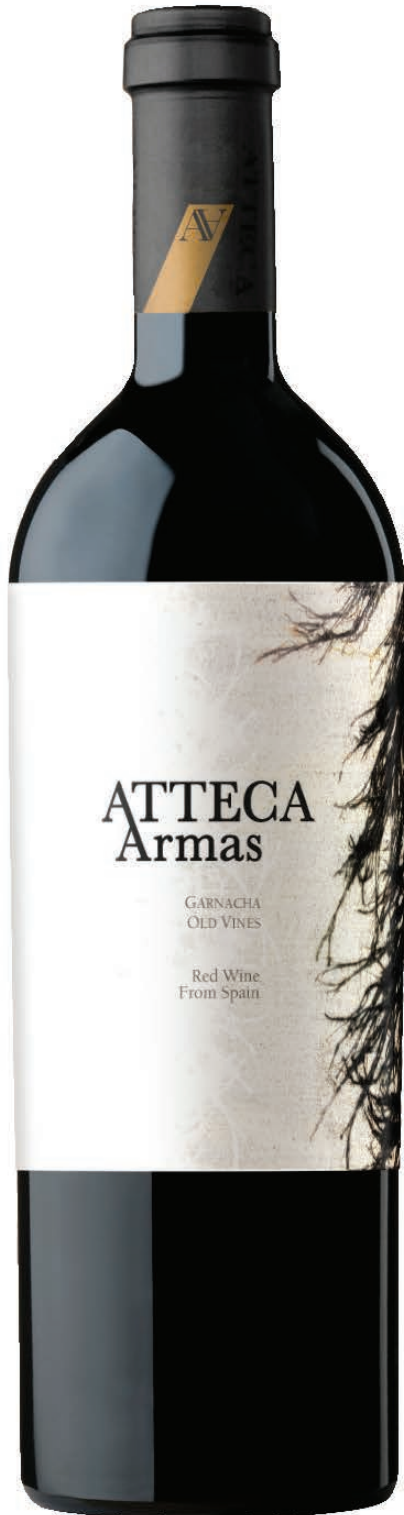

TASTING NOTES

Deep cherry red, with an intense and attractive nose. Ripe fruit, roasted and spicy notes from the barrel with a mineral taste from the slate soil where the vine grows. A complex, fruity, powerful and elegant wine on the palate. Full bodied yet velvety at the same time, with a great presence of fruit. Bold tannins.

VINEYARDS

Very old vines of Garnacha are planted on the hillsides at about 3,000 feet above sea level, with a very low level of rains and without irrigation to obtain very low yields and a limited harvest.
