**VINEYARDS**

Rejón is the name of the most prominent vineyard of Tempranillo at Bodegas Tridente. Located in the town of El Pego, within Toro's appellation, the 130 year old vines are planted in sandy soil with a copious top layer of gravel. The low yielding vines equate to limited production with the objective to retain the typicity of the indigenous varietal coming from this unique terrior. The grapes are carefully hand-picked in small, 15kg baskets, fermented in small vats and moved to 225 liter French oak barrels to mature before bottling.
