Vineyards

The Cariñena and Garnacha vines used for the production of these wines have an approximate age ranging from 25 to 40 years. The vineyards of Garnacha are around 2,000 ft in altitude in the area of Cornudella de Montsant on slate soils, Cariñena vineyards in the Darmós and Masroig area are on clay soils, and the Syrah vineyards are located on limestone soils.

Ripe black and blue fruit scents carry smoky mineral and licorice nuances and a subtle touch of violet. Sappy and seamless in texture, offering sweet boysenberry and floral pastille flavors and a jolt of enlivening spiciness. Finishes silky, energetic and quite long, with lingering florality and sneaky tannic grip.”
